The gallery is open seven days a week and members tend to the clerking duties on a rotating schedule. Clerk duties include: gallery sales, transactions of cash, check and credit cards, balancing the day's transactions, making bank deposits, studio housekeeping, and greeting the public in a professional and cordial manner. Since we are a working pottery studio, the members are encouraged to work and demonstrate techniques to our visitors during the duty day.

The Potters' Guild relies on the efforts of its member for its continued growth and vitality. Members must be available to serve on committees and be chairpersons of various efforts as well as officers of the group.

We are a limited membership. Jurying takes place in the spring, if there are positions vacant. The specific days and times for delivery and pick-up of the ware submitted to jury is published by the Guild prior to each jury date.
